# **HOW** does this work?

These meetings can take place at a coffee shop, BSM building, somewhere on campus, etc. These meetings can last about 15-30 minutes.

- 1. You can set an appointment by phone call.
- 2. If they don't answer, leave a voicemail.
- 3. Then, shoot a follow-up text.
